Describe your relevant experience

I have practiced Scrum since 2006 (13 years) and have used it in software development in many industries. My clients include Walgreens, Border States Electric, Criteo, Western Union, Oracle, Wells Fargo Bank, and The Coast Distribution System.

Please describe the importance of depth of inheritance as a measure of code quality.

Depth of Inheritance is a measure of how complex an inheritance scheme is for controlling the methods and data elements in a class based language such as Java or C++. A shorter parent class tree means that the location of relevant elements is easy to find. A taller "tree" with wider "branches" opens the door to duplication and unwanted side-effects.

Please describe the way that BDD affects the contents of a Product Backlog.

Behaviour Driven Development (BDD) provides a systematic and formal way to describe desired behaviour. It uses statements beginning with 'Given', 'When' and 'Then' to describe results (the "Then" statements) of actions (the "When" statements) in specified contexts (the "Given" statements).
